

## **CCC** - **C**lean – **C**heck – **C**onfirm

Soybean seed treatments are growing in popularity and very few acres are planted without the seed treatment. As a producer who chooses to use these seed treatments at planting, you must also be aware that this seed is only accepted in the soil. This means, these soybean must not show up in any food supply item. Consequently, no elevator or soybean processor can accept soybeans that have had a seed treatment applied to them.

As a result of this, you must manage your equipment to prevent any cross contamination between the seed beans and your soybeans you are taking to market. You must thoroughly clean any grain carts, trucks, and etc hauling soybeans to market to assure you will not be rejected at your destination.

One treated soybean seed is grounds for rejection.

South Dakota Soybean Processors has a zero tolerance for treated soybeans.

Remember **CCC** when preparing to haul soybeans to market.

**CCC** = **C**lean – **C**heck – **C**onfirm.
